## Admission Requirements

### Program Eligibility

#### Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, including these required courses:

- One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U), minimum 60%

plus

- Mathematics, Grade 12 (C or U) or mathematics, Grade 11 (M or U\*) \* MBF3C does not meet this requirement.
- Minimum 65% overall average required for PBUSP, PBAFI, PBUFI
- Minimum 70% overall average required for PBAFC

or

Mature student status.

### Applicant Selection

Eligible applicants are selected on the basis of previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including required courses).

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program will be assessed and advised individually and may be considered for other, related programs.

\*Course duration for September starts (two-year program) is two academic years. Course duration for January starts (two-year program) is 16 months continuous.

### English Language Proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
