Admission Requirements

Program Eligibility

Ontario Secondary School Diploma, or equivalent, including these required courses:

- One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U)
- Mathematics, Grade 11 (C, M or U)

or

Mature student status.

NEW: Requirements for Fall 2019

For students starting this program in Fall 2019 or later, the admission requirements will be as follows:

Ontario Secondary School Diploma, or equivalent, including these required courses:

- One English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or ENG4U)
- Mathematics, Grade 11 (C, M or U) with a minimum 60% or Mathematics, Grade 12 (C, M or U)

Applicant Selection

Eligible applicants will be selected on the basis of their previous academic achievement (the average of their six highest senior-level credits, including required courses).

Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements for this program will be assessed and advised individually and may be considered for other, related programs.

English Language Proficiency

All applicants whose first language is not English must meet Sheridan's English proficiency requirements.
